# APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF MEETING OF DECEMBER 2013 MEETING

Agreed as true record. A budget of £7500.00 was agreed for the next financial year.

### 1. APPROVAL OF BUDGET.

It was agreed that the precept be increased to £ 7500.00 Next year the budget layout will be changed to show monthly columns with running totals

The figures were approved subject to Cllr Lewis's corrections and layout changes. All agreed to accept minutes with corrections.

### 3. VILLAGE PLAN REPORT

A steering group meeting will be held on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> January to agree on final version of Document. The Village Plan should be adopted by the end of January.

#### 4. HIGHWAYS AND OPEN AREAS

A query has been raised about trees overhanging paths. Proprietors have the right to remove braches overhanging their property. Some trees were planted by the Parish Council in the 1980's after Dutch elm disease caused damage to trees in the village.

A proposal for a living Christmas tree on the Green was discussed, after some argument, it was agreed that a permanent Christmas tree would not be appropriate.

The sycamore opposite the pub is dying and needs to be removed. Bucks Tree surgeons to be approached to confirm their earlier quote is still valid.

It was agreed that when a tree was removed, a replacement should be planted, possibly in a different location. All agreed, with one in favour of removal and 2 in favour of replacement. Cllr Mrs Towell asked for it to be minuted that a replacement is being discussed but location to be identified.

# 5. ORDERS FOR PAYMENT AND FINANCIAL MATTERS
