#### 3. PUBLIC SESSION (SUSPENSION OF STANDING ORDERS)

Dog Bins - A survey has been conducted as to possible locations for dog bins. It was suggested that one could be put by stile behind undergrowth above the salt bin on footpath from Church lane to Railway line. Alternatively one could be sited by footpath that goes behind Manor Villas. There were 2 -3 signs in various locations asking people to remove dog mess. The cost of the bins is £242.12 per bin for installation and emptying, which is 1.99 per week per bin. Cllr Mrs Towell advised the meeting that there was little justification in asking people to remove dog mess if there was nowhere to put it. It was agreed that this should be discussed at the budget Meeting.

Mrs Tillier asked for the bench by the War Memorial to be removed before the Remembrance Sunday ceremony. She also asked when the salt bins would fill.

Mrs Parks requested an update on the situation regarding kerbing Dark Lane. This is covered later in agenda.

Shop- The application for change of use for the tea rooms has been passed. There are no definite developments to report
